We fight our way back, and in the $8^{\text {th }}$ inning, Home Run Baker does what his nickname says: He hits a 2 run homer to take the lead for Starrucca; 4-3.
Span bullpen has tossed goose eggs since the $3^{\text {rd }}$ inning. This also gave Mgr Hebscher an opportunity to tell us the story on how Baker got his moniker of HomeRun. Seems he was in a World Series or Playoff game early in his career and powered out TWO homeruns in the series, which was mostly unheard of in that day. The nickname stuck with him his whole career.

Mattern used the Intentional Walk to get out of a jam in the $16^{\text {th }}$, but here in the $17^{\text {th }}$ when he tries it again, it bites him in the ass. He ends up loading the bases, and then, WALKING in the winning run with the bases loaded!!!
Spans win one, finally, 3-2. Note: every game so far has been a 1 run game decided in a teams last at bats.
Both mgrs. have lowered their life expectancy by 5 years!

GAME 5:
We return to our post-regulation ways....but to get there, we needed a clutch 2 run double to drive in the tying runs by Chief Wilson. Wilson was $2^{\text {nd }}$ in the league in RBl's and he never drove in 2 more important than this pair.
We play the $10^{\text {th }}, 11^{\text {th }}, 12^{\text {th }}, 13^{\text {th }}$, and then the $14^{\text {th }}$. Fans are getting restless and the mgrs . are burning out. Both of us had opportunities to score, and just couldn't push the run across. Willie Keeler threw out a runner at Home from leftfield, trying to score the winning run. Tecumseh shortstop Mickey Dooan threw a runner out at the plate to keep the game going.
Finally, in the $14^{\text {th }}$, London was left with AI Mattern again as the last pitcher in their bullpen. And Mattern is nothing if not consistant; for his second game in a row, he first loaded the bases, and then walked another batter, driving in the game winning run!
Spans win! Spans Win! 3-2! They've left a dozen runners on base, but finally push one across.
At this point, we've been going for 3 and a half hours, and a dozen reboots with Zoom. We were burned out. Starrucca was holding on by the skin of their teeth. They won TWO games, in xtra innings, when the opposing pitcher WALKED the batter with the bases loaded, to lose the game! Without that wildness, we would have been swept and sent on our way. We now live to fight another day.

These first five games though had to have been one of the most tense, yet satisfying contests I can remember having. Both mgrs. pulled out all the stops, used as many players on the roster that they could, and saw the lead turn around in the blink of an eye.


## GAME 6:

After a nite of not much rest, we reconvene: Starrucca breaks fast out of the gate.....scoring 3 big runs in the top of the first! We obviously needed our rest before this one.
We take a 5-0 lead into the bottom of the $4^{\text {th }}$, and figure we can coast.
2 runs came on another homerun by Home Run Baker! (I'm just glad his nickname wasn't "Bunt Single Baker" as we would still be at home plate trying to beat one out!)
Thinking again that we could coast, London proved to us that we couldn't.
They come back with 3 fast runs, now 5-3, and we end up winning this one 6-4, the game being in doubt right up til the last batter.
Interesting Tidbit: Ed's story on HomeRun Bakers nickname.....came true today; he hit TWO out so far in the series. The only two of the entire match.
The series is now TIED at 3 games apiece.....we go to the Finale with either team showing satisfaction at a series well played and ultra competitive.


## GAME 7:

George Mullin and 3 Span Relievers shut down the London offense today. They got caught stealing twice as they were trying anything they could to get a rally started. Mullin pitched great in a 3-0 win, the Tecumsehs just looking a little tired and worn out at the plate today. Starrucca comes from behind to take the series 4 games to 3 !
Hats off to London GM who kept his boys running and shined from the field as at least 3-4 outfielders gunned out Span runners at the plate!

Starrucca wins and will now advance to the World Series against the winner of Bradenton/Pittsburgh.


The Rebels (93-61) and Buckeyes (97-57) would open the best-of-seven series in Shaffer Stadium. Bradenton had won 5 of 8 games between the teams in the regular season and pitched a bit better ( 2.57 vs 2.65 ) than the Rebels, who out-fielded the Buckeyes (3rd @. 970 vs 4th @ .965). Both teams hit . 246 this year but Pittsburgh averaged 4.4 runs per game, outscoring their opponents 684 to 516 . Bradenton averaged only 4.1 runs per game, and outscored their opposition 633 to 540.
Pittsburgh out-homered Bradenton 25-11 this year and stole 8 more bases than the Buckeyes (224 to 216).

## Weds September 29

Art Fromme (21-13, 2.29) and Orval Overall (27-7, 1.12) would carry their teams' hopes to the mound in the opener. The game was scoreless until the 6th inning when Rube Ellis singled to give the Rebels the lead. Bradenton then took the lead in the home half, scoring on a SF by Kid Elberfeld and a 2-run Gabby Street 1B.
A bunt DP killed a 7th inning Pittsburgh threat.
The Buckeyes chased Fromme with a 4-run 7th, taking a commanding 7-1 lead.
Deciding a 6-run lead with 6 outs to go was safe, Bradenton gave Overall the rest of the afternoon off.
Colby Jack Coombs took the mound and faced only 4 hitters - they all singled! Deacon Phillippe relieved and immediately gave up a 2-run single to the hot hitting Ellis, cutting the lead to 7-4. Chief Meyers doubled on the next pitch and it was a 7-6 contest. Baldy Flanagan pinch hit, tying the score with a SF. Vic Willis finally got the 3rd out. In the top of the 9th, Tris Speaker broke the tie with an RBI double. Meyers squeezed home an insurance run. Rebel Oakes dropped a fly ball in LF to make it 10-7. Baldy Flanagan then capped the scoring with an RBI triple.

George McQuillan (23-8, 1.80) and Howie Camnitz (24-12, 2.01) took the mound for what might be the final game of the season in Shaffer Stadium.
Pittsburgh again struck first, scoring in the 2nd inning on an infield single by George Stovall. Baldy Flanagan then added insurance with a 2-run double. Tris Speaker robbed Nap LaJoie of extra bases to end the 3rd inning, but crashed into the CF wall (1 day - the travel day).
Bradenton loaded the bases in the bottom of the 4th inning with no one out. McQuillan then struck out Woody Wood and induced a GDP from Gabby Street.
That was that, and Pittsburgh had completed the sweep in Shaffer Stadium
